D. BUSINESS PRESENTED BY POLICE DEPARTMENT

1. APPROVE PURCHASE OF POLICE VEHICLES BUDGETED FOR 2016

Police Chief Kelley explained that there are four (4) vehicles in the 2016 Police Capital Budget for purchase. He distributed a paper showing the vehicles to be purchased, which current vehicles the new vehicles would replace, cost, and trade in values. Alderperson Miller arrived at this time. Chief Kelley commented that the Interceptor and the Promaster will come from Ewald in Milwaukee through the state bid program, and the Ram and the Charger will come from Dearth's here in town. Brief discussion took place. A motion was made by Alderperson Miller, with a second from Alderperson Bauman to recommend the Police Department Vehicle Purchases for 2016 in the amount of \$99,460.00 to Council. On voice vote, the motion carried by Youth In Government members and then by the Public Safety Committee official members.
