- **D. Park Director's Report** Paul gave his report and highlighted the following: A \$10,000 donation from Badger State Ethanol for the Twining shelter. Nate Klassy was instrumental in getting us this donation. Bids for the shelter opened for the second time on February 2nd. KSW Construction's quote of \$441,141.50 was the quote that was accepted. KSW is from Verona, they have done two park shelters for Fitchburg which they have been happy with. We have set up 107 terrace ash trees and 20 park ash trees for treatment. Tru-Green Madison will be doing the treatment. Whitney Tree Service has started tree removals and trimming. There are 58 trees marked for removal. Trees have been ordered for terrace tree planting. Advertised for a part time person to work April October. Working on quotes for spring projects such as bandshell staining and painting, replacing the roof on the Recreation South Shelter, replacing doors at the pool and specifications for the dog park fencing. Mrs. Frank Dillon gave \$1,500 toward the flag pole for the Twining ball fields. Tom Witt is making the Dale Buvid sign for the Twining East Scoreboard. Also listed were spring, summer and fall projects.
