A. ROLL CALL

Chairperson Thoman called the meeting to order. Present at roll call were Alderpersons Thoman and Beer. Alder Boyce arrived later in the meeting. Also present were Mayor Armstrong, other city staff, alderpersons, and citizens.

C. BUSINESS

1. TEMPORARY "CLASS B" FERMENTED MALT BEVERAGE AND WINE LICENSE APPLICATION FROM HABITAT FOR HUMANITY OF GREEN COUNTY FOR OUTDOOR BEER GARDEN IN CONJUNCTION WITH MAIN STREET MONROE CONCERTS ON THE SQUARE
City Clerk Stamm explained. Alderperson Boyce arrived at this time. Motion made by Alderperson Beer and seconded by Alderperson Boyce to approve. Motion carried.
2. TEMPORARY CLASS "B" FERMENTED MALT BEVERAGE LICENSE APPLICATION FROM MONROE YOUTH HOCKEY ASSOCIATION FOR OUTDOOR BEER GARDEN IN CONJUNCTION WITH SWISS VALLEY HARLEY DAVIDSON OPEN HOUSE
City Clerk Stamm again explained. Motion to approve made by Alderperson Beer and seconded by Alderperson Boyce. Motion carried.
3. "CLASS A" FERMENTED MALT BEVERAGE AND CIDER ONLY LICENSE APPLICATION FROM SHOPKO HOLDING COMPANY, LLC
City Clerk Stamm explained that this is a new license application. Questions and discussion ensued. Motion to approve made by Alderperson Beer and seconded by Alderperson Boyce. Motion carried.
4. LIQUOR, FERMENTED MALT BEVERAGE, DANCE, OPERATOR, AND OTHER MISCELLANEOUS LICENSE APPLICATIONS AND ANNUAL RENEWALS
City Clerk Stamm explained. There are 2 operator (bartender) licenses that should be denied upon recommendation of Police Chief Kelley because they provided false information on their application. Questions and discussion took place. Motion made by Alderperson Boyce and seconded by Alderperson Beer to deny the two operator licenses (Alden Mejia and Ernesto Vargas). Motion carried.

City Clerk Stamm then explained that Santos Tinoco (Veracruz) failed to turn in his license renewal application on time. In order to meet the 15 day waiting period requirement, the license can't be granted until the July 5th meetings. Questions and discussion took place regarding why the city issues dance licenses. Motion made by Alderperson Beer and seconded by Alderperson Boyce to approve all the rest of the renewals. Motion carried.

Alder Boyce asked about the proposed alcohol ordinance revisions. City Clerk Stamm explained the status of this. Alder Boyce also questioned when the temporary alcohol licenses for Cheese Days would be approved. He wanted to make sure that the city wasn't waiting until all the applications were in before approving them.
