### **D. BUSINESS PRESENTED BY POLICE DEPARTMENT**

#### **1. LONG TERM AMPLIFIED SOUND PERMIT APPLICATION FROM WAL-MART FOR PERIOD OF JULY 1, 2016 – JUNE 30, 2017.**

Clerk Stamm explained this was their annual renewal application. It was turned in late so it was not included with the others at the last meeting. ##### **1. Jordan Lutheran Church Outdoor Service**

Chief Kelly explained it is an outdoor church service at Twining Park on July 10<sup>th</sup> from 12-7pm. All permits are turned in and he would recommend approving.

##### **2. Green Count Fair Association Green County Fair**

Chief Kelly explained this was the Green County Fair. He said the only real change was the moving of the Demo Derby from Sunday night to Saturday night. The only thing on Sunday now is routine stuff and fair will really be over by 10 pm on Sunday. The License Committee will see that the temporary beer permit for the Legion will have to reflect the fair hours. The no parking zones will be the same as in previous years, nothing new other than the moving of events, and they (Police Department) will be staffing accordingly. Police Chief Kelley said he recommend approving this one as well.

Alder Miller made the motion to approve both special event permit applications. Motion was seconded by Alder Bauman. Motion carried on voice vote.
