D. BUSINESS PRESENTED BY POLICE DEPARTMENT

1. CONSIDER SPECIAL EVENT PERMIT APPLICATIONS FOR RECOMMENDATION TO COMMON COUNCIL

1. FAITH Addiction Awareness of Green County 5K Run and Walk

Police Chief Kelley explained the event is scheduled for August 27th from 8am – 11am. This is the 2nd year for this event. It will be held on Monroe Clinic property and the run will be through the neighborhood North of Twining Park and back.

2. PARKING ENFORCEMENT PROGRAM

Police Chief Kelley explained they went back to Republic Parking with a list of questions that came out of the last meeting. He said that using a 3rd part vendor will give a better look and we would not save much money by doing it ourselves. There would be many things we would have to take on if we did ourselves that they would bring to us. Either way we would have to purchase the equipment from them. He said they do offer a discount of 15% if we did a three year agreement. The savings would be \$10,800 over the three years. Discussion took place. At the end of the agreement the equipment would belong to us as we have to purchase it. If we decided to do ourselves we could continue using the equipment and the software. More discussion took place. Mayor Armstrong arrived at this point.

Alder Miller spoke about his thoughts of having a Police Officer doing this rather than hiring an outside vendor. Discussion took place. Alder Bauman made a motion to send it to the Tax and

Finance committee to find the funding for a one year trial. Miller seconded the motion. Motion carried on voice vote.

Discussion took place about where it would go after the Tax and Finance committee, to set the fees, fines, time limits, etc.
